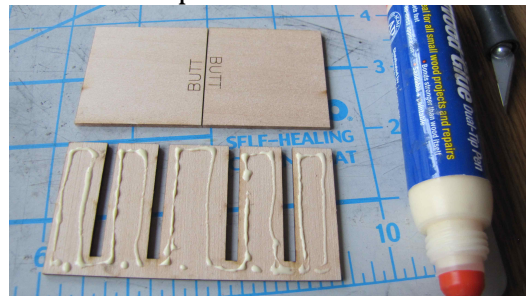
Sand top of roof pieces



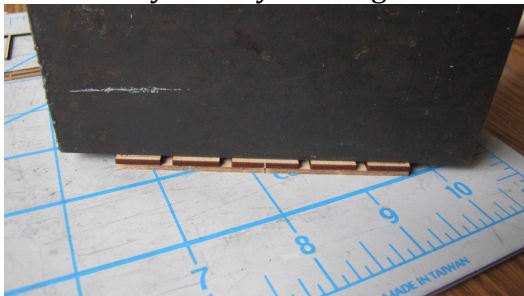

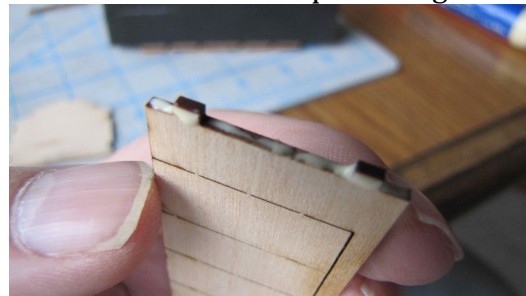

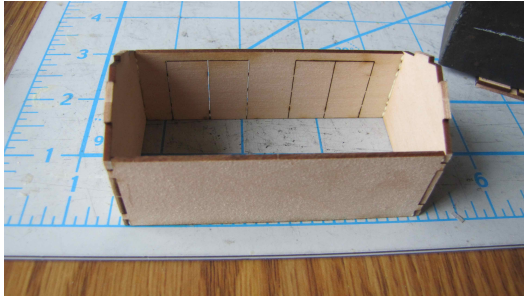
Glue the 3 foundation pieces together.



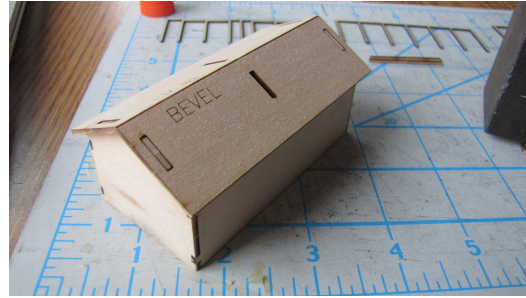

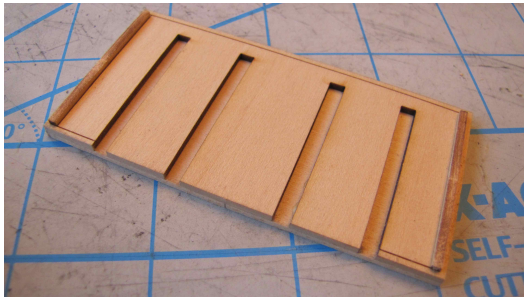
Glue the 4 sides keeping them square.



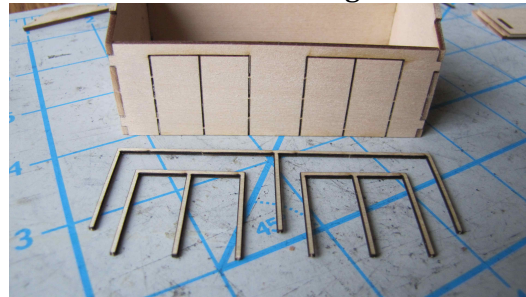

Check the roof but don't glue.



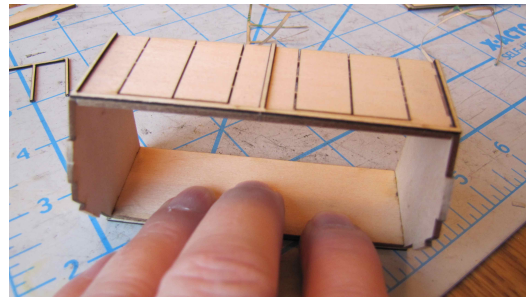

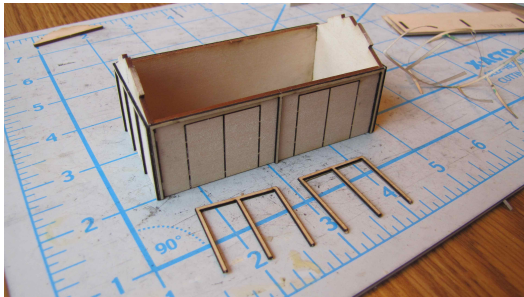
Now work on the trim.



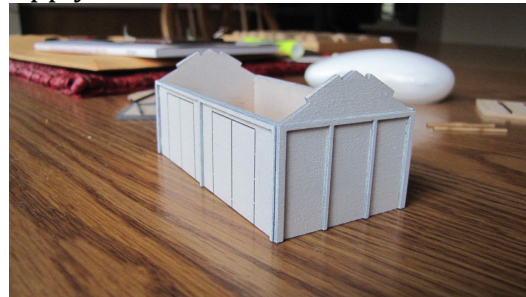
Peel off backer from double stick.



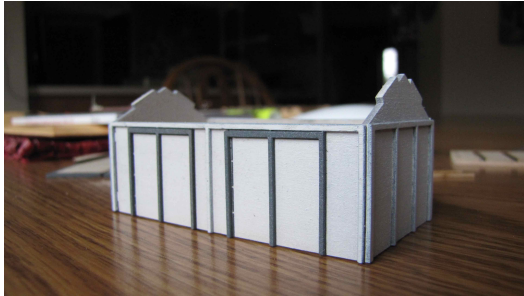
Apply to sides.



Don't adhere door if a different color.



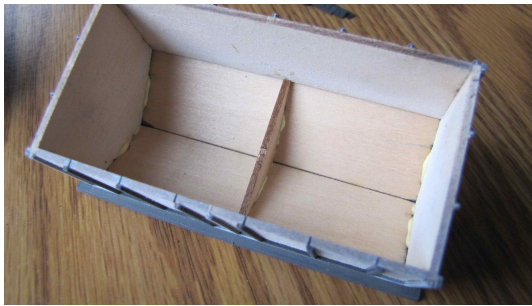
Paint the shed white.



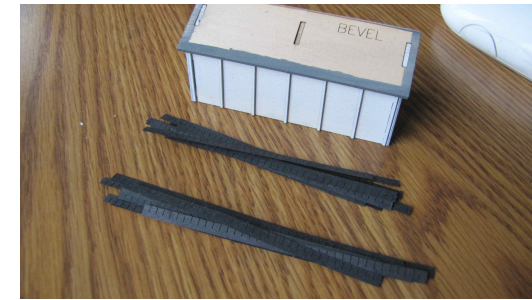
Paint door trim then adhere.



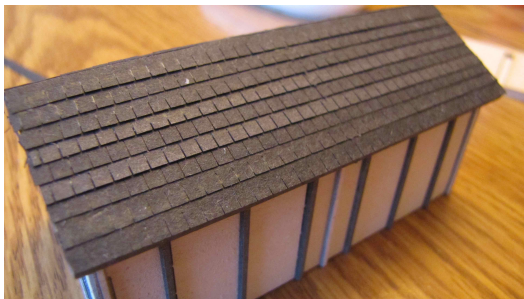
Paint exposed roof underside.



Glue on roof and roof truss.



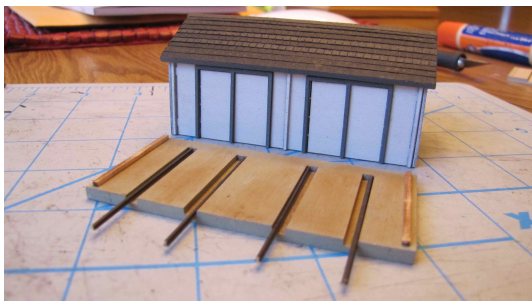
Shingle the roof by gluing on the strips.



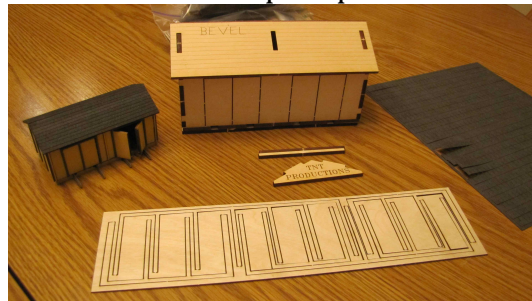
Almost finished roof.



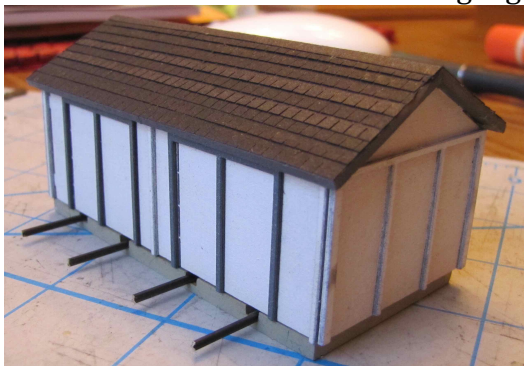
Glue on the roof cap strip then cut excess.
